COUNCIL MEETING December 11, 2019 Unapproved Minutes

Members Present:

Chuck Moon, Jo Foss, Jaime Fogt, Marilyn Krogh, and Bill Jansen; also present was Treasurer Heidi Moon. Absent were Cheryl Kohner and Andy May.

Chuck called the meeting to order. Members checked in with each other. Heidi offered prayer.

NOVEMBER MINUTES:

The minutes were reviewed. Jo made a motion to accept minutes as written, Jaime second. Motion carried.

NOVEMBER TREASURER'S **REPORT**: This was reviewed. Heidi reported the AED pads and alarm batteries have been replaced at cost of \$125.00, and asked if that amount could be taken from the nondesignated memorials. A motion was made by Marilyn, second by Jo to take the money from the nondesignated memorials account. Motion carried.

MINISTRY REPORTS:

• Property—Chuck met with Denny, Cybert PC and Matt Klocke regarding the security cameras. It was decided to purchase three cameras, and mount them inside the

church facing the doors. The cost will be roughly \$1,300. Gene Olesen has volunteered to cover this

- Family Ministry—Jo reported a rehearsal was held for the Christmas program which will be on Sunday, December 15th. Members will also deliver cookies to the people on our prayer list. Faith Alive will not be held during the school's Christmas break.
- Music and Worship— Bill reported Sunday pulpit supply is scheduled through the beginning of March. Council discussed options for calling a part-time pastor.
- Circle of Faith—The Christmas trees in the fellowship area and basement have been decorated. The Christmas craft fair was held on December 7th raising \$2,003.70 before expenses. This money will go toward the basement flooring project.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Church Security—See above under Property Committee report.
- Pastor—Time was taken to discuss options.
- Christmas Eve pulpit supply—Pastor Bill Reck is coming from St. Cloud.

New Business:

- Ash Wednesday—Soup suppers and pulpit supply were discussed.
- Christmas Eve poinsettias—will be arriving Monday, December 23rd.

• Date for annual meeting will be Sunday, February 9, 2020.

- Chuck will contact Brenda Tibbets, Assistant to the Bishop about our call process.
- Outgoing council members are asked to return your church binders. Council thanks Jaime and Bill for their service.
- Ministry Team Liaisons please be sure their team's annual reports are turned in by Monday, December 30th.
- Jo will talk with Circle of Faith about soup suppers during Lent.

Bill made a motion to adjourn the meeting, second by Jaime. Meeting adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.
