TREASURER'S REPORT:

December 2021 and January 2022 were discussed. Expenses were noted to be higher in January for multiple reasons.

PASTOR'S REPORT: Clara provided a summary for her contacts and service work from last month. Bill and Clara met. Three congregational reboot zoom meetings attended. Open prayer will be held on February 17th. Lenten soup service will be held at 6:30 on Wednesdays. National Youth Gathering in MN cancelled. Clara brought up the idea of having a social media team. Another local congregation has seen an increase in attendance through people tuning in online since introducing an enhanced online presence. Brought up VBS planning, which will be

handled by the Family Ministry team. Suggested using the back covered area for a Farmer's Market in the summer. Clara's schedule for April will be the 10^{th} and 24^{th} .
