

COUNCIL MEETING

April 14, 2021 Unapproved Minutes

MEMBERS PRESENT: Linda Jensen, Bill Jansen, Marilyn Krogh, Chuck Moon, Heidi Moon, and Clara Edin; Andy May was absent.

CHECK-INS, DEVOTION AND OPENING PRAYER: Bill read from Luke 23.

ACCEPT MINUTES OF MARCH 2021 MEETINGS: March council meeting and special called council minutes were reviewed. A motion was made by Chuck, second by Linda to accept the minutes as written, motion carried.

MARCH TREASURER'S REPORT: Reviewed.

PASTOR'S REPORT: Clara reported having contact with two people who expressed interest in becoming members of BLC. She will be working with them.

MINISTRY TEAMS:

- Property—Chuck reported nothing new from Denny (Linda indicated stump removers working with Ovid at the cemetery should arrive in the next two weeks for church stumps).
- Family Ministry—Bill reported Bible Study will continue through May on the first and third Wednesdays. There will be a Zoom meeting

on May 12th at 4 pm to discuss summer programs, and there is a \$200 scholarship available to anyone wishing to attend Lutheran Bible/Summer Camp.

- Music and Worship— Linda reported the hymns for April have been chosen.
- Circle of Faith—Will be honoring our graduate Emma Jansen this year with cake and coffee on May 23rd after services.

AD HOC COMMITTEES' REPORTS:

- Call Committee—Ron Foss reported there had been no activity during the past month.
- SMART Team—Bill went over the modifications made to the plan at their April meeting. A copy of the current SMART plan is posted in the entryway of the church and on the website. A motion was made by Heidi to accept the changes, second by Bill, motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Parsonage proceeds— Discussion was had on re-roofing the church.
 Concern was expressed regarding if there is damage caused because of bad shingles, our insurance may not cover the damage done. For now, no action is taken on investing the proceeds.
- Clara's May schedule— Clara's contract is for 15 hours per week to include two Sundays per month but is flexible on the remaining two Sundays, depending on her

continuing education classes and/or required seminar attendance. On those Sundays when Clara is away, pulpit supply will be utilized.

New Business:

- Adopt-a-highway—
 There is a section north of Askov available. An announcement will be made to the congregation to see if there is interest in pursuing.
- Live streaming training—Bill is looking to train one or two more people to operate the live streaming equipment which provides online viewing of Sunday services. It was recommended that a new tablet be purchased for this purpose, so any trainees won't need to use their personal cell phones for the streaming app.

Action Items:

- Heidi was asked to make and post signs to address the issue of proximity and mingling after church services. This should be done outside the building.
- Bill will make calls to see if anyone might be interested in training on the live streaming equipment.

Motion by Bill, second by Heidi to adjourn the meeting, motion carried. Meeting adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.

Our next meeting will be on Wednesday, May 12, 2021 at 6 pm.

graduate, Emma Jansen, during the church service on Sunday, May 23rd.


