
A Message From Our SAM

The Tomb is empty..... Now what?

This is at the center of our Christian proclamation. All four of our Gospels describe the discovery of the empty tomb (Matthew 28:1–6; Mark 16:1–7; Luke 24:1–12; John 20:1–12). With the news of Jesus' tomb being empty I would think the Jewish religious leaders would have taken the short walk to Joseph's tomb to verify the news going around. They had every motivation to produce Jesus' corpse to end the rumors of this resurrection... but they could not. Christianity began to gain converts because they could not produce a body. The tomb was found empty! The man who was buried there had risen from the dead! Jesus would not only vacate His grave but appeared to numerous people individually (Luke 24:34) and in groups (Matthew 28:9; John 20:26–30; 21:1–14; Acts 1:3–6;

<u>1 Corinthians 15:3–7</u>). His resurrection from the dead would be the **sure proof** that **He was who He claimed to be** (<u>Matthew 12:38–40</u>; <u>16:1–4</u>)—**the risen Son of God, <u>our only hope of salvation!</u> Alleluia!**

Now what? We get to live knowing of this hope! We get to live as Jesus wants us to.... Loving and caring for each other as he loved and cared for us individually on the cross – Cleansing us of our sins and giving us this new life we are living with him! As he told his disciples – Go and share the **GOOD**

ACH or EFT giving is a way for our church to receive offerings by automatic electronic transfers from your checking or savings account.


WHY IS ACH GIVING IMPORTANT?
